

Update 7 - Impact of the Noto Peninsula Earthquake which occurred on January 1, 2024

We would like to express our sincere condolences to those who suffered this earthquake and other impacts which were caused by the earthquake.

We would like to inform you of the 7th report regarding the impact of the earthquake centered in the Noto region of Ishikawa Prefecture (Noto Peninsula Earthquake) which occurred on January 1 (Monday), 2024.

The latest confirmation status at our production facilities of Ishikawa Sanken (Horimatsu, Shika and Noto plants) near the epicenter is as follows.

1. Status of employees

We are providing livelihood support to employees who have forced to evacuate due to the earthquake. We are also considering future work attendance arrangements

2. Plant damage

- i) We expect to complete safety checks on some of the buildings by construction experts within a week.
- ii) For the production facilities, we are in the process of confirmation. Regarding some production lines, we are making preparations for the resumption of production.
- iii) For the water supply for industrial use, the restoration area of water infrastructure in Ishikawa prefecture is gradually expanding. We are in discussions with local governments to ensure a stable water supply to our plant. We are also planning the use of water supply trucks for replenishment, utilizing water tanks inside the plant.
- iv) To ensure power supply at Shika plant, we are coordinating and discussing with the power company. Concurrently, we are also continuing to explore the possibility of external power supply.

3. Resumption of Production

Based on the situations mentioned above, we are planning to resume some production lines at Ishikawa Sanken (Horimatsu and Noto plants) in early February.
