Update 8 - Impact of the Noto Peninsula Earthquake which occurred on January 1, 2024

We would like to express our sincere condolences to those who suffered this earthquake and other impacts which were caused by the earthquake.

We would like to inform you of the 8th report regarding the impact of the earthquake centered in the Noto region of Ishikawa Prefecture (Noto Peninsula Earthquake) which occurred on January 1 (Monday), 2024.

The latest restoration status at our production facilities of Ishikawa Sanken (Horimatsu, Shika and Noto plants) is as follows.

Infrastructure

- i) For the water supply for industrial use, with the cooperation of local governments, we expect to be able to use the partially restored water supply system and water trucks to each plant.
- ii) At Shika plant, where power outages continued until last week, the power supply has been restored with the cooperation of the power company.

We would like to express our deepest gratitude to the local governments and all those involved for their efforts.

Resumption of Production

In the 7th report, we announced that some production lines at Horimatsu and Noto plants are planned to resume in early February. As mentioned above, power has been restored at Shika plant. However, since we expect that it will take some time for resumption of production, we will continue to accelerate the restoration activities. Therefore, we have decided to produce some of Shika plant's products on alternative production lines at Horimatsu plant. Through these efforts, we are planning to achieve an early resumption of production for Ishikawa Sanken products.
