Update 11 - Impact of the Noto Peninsula Earthquake which occurred on January 1, 2024

We would like to inform you of the 11th report regarding the impact of the earthquake centered in the Noto region of Ishikawa Prefecture (Noto Peninsula Earthquake) which occurred on January 1 (Monday), 2024.

## Resumption of Production at Shika plant

In our 10th report, we announced that some production processes at Shika plant would resume in mid-February, and now that the production preparations have been completed, Shika plant has partially resumed production as of today.

Regarding the alternative production at Horimatsu plant for some products manufactured at Shika plant, we already started it on February 6.

Shika plant, which had been delayed in restoration, has resumed production as mentioned above. As previously announced, Horimatsu and Noto plants resumed production on January 30, and now all three plants of Ishikawa Sanken are operational. We will continue our restoration efforts.
