The latest status at our production facilities of Ishikawa Sanken (Horimatsu, Shika and Noto plants) is as follows.

- Horimatsu and Noto plants are expected to resume full production by mid-March.
- Shika plant is expected to resume full production by the end of March, including alternative production at Horimatsu plant.

We have been working on restoration activities at Ishikawa Sanken, which was damaged by the earthquake, and we expect to resume full production at three plants next month as mentioned above.

We would like to apologize for the great concern and inconvenience caused by the earthquake. We would also like to express our sincere gratitude to related ministries and agencies, local governments, business partners, shareholders and others who have cooperated and supported our recovery efforts.
