

Recovery from “The 2011 off the Pacific coast of Tohoku Earthquake”

(Update 2, as of 3:00 pm, March 17)

The impact and recovery efforts from the 2011 off the Pacific coast of Tohoku Earthquake at the 3 affected Sanken production sites are as follows.

1. No human casualty was confirmed, and none of the buildings suffered major damages.
2. Yamagata Sanken Co., Ltd. (Higashine, Yamagata Prefecture), and Fukushima Sanken Co., Ltd. (Nihonmatsu, Fukushima Prefecture) started to receive stable supply of electric power, and both sites are now accelerating their efforts for recovery of their production lines.
Kashima Sanken Co., Ltd. (Kamisu, Ibaragi Prefecture) has resumed production in a number of its manufacturing lines. The projected full recovery schedule will be announced when and as appropriate.
3. Sanken and all of its affiliated companies are currently making every effort to resume and increase supply of our products to our customers. We regret, however, to inform that due to lack of logistics social infrastructure and inconveniences caused by rolling black-outs, our latest estimate tells that it takes some more time until we regain our stable, full capacity for production and shipment of our products.
