Recovery from "The 2011 off the Pacific coast of Tohoku Earthquake"

The impact and recovery efforts from the 2011 off the Pacific coast of Tohoku Earthquake at Sanken's production sites are as follows.

1. Human Casualty

No human casualty was recorded among staff and associates of Sanken and its affiliates.

2. Recovery at Production Sites

Production sites	Recovery status
Yamagata Sanken Co., Ltd. (Higashine, Yamagata Prefecture)	 No damage to the buildings and no disruption in supply of electric power. A number of production lines resumed operation.
Fukushima Sanken Co., Ltd. (Nihonmatsu, Fukushima Prefecture)	 No damage to the buildings and no disruption in supply of electric power. All production lines have completed recovery process, and the operations have returned close to normal.
Kashima Sanken Co., Ltd. (Kamisu, Ibaraki Prefecture)	 No damage to the buildings and no disruption in supply of electric power. All production lines have completed recovery process, and the operations have returned close to normal.

3. Recovery Prospects

The projected full recovery schedule will be announced when and as appropriate.

At present, Sanken and all of its affiliates are making every effort to resume and increase supply of our products to our customers. We regret, however, to inform that due to troubles in logistics social infrastructure and inconveniences caused by rolling black-outs, our latest estimate tells that it takes some time before we regain our stable, full production and shipment of our products.
